NEW QUALIFYING RULES To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes.
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four, and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
4. Return the card to together with any membership fees due **within 14 days** of this show. *Please Note: Membership fees after 31st January 2008 - £20*

SHOWLAND NATIVE SOCIETY ELITE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW.

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies of all ages registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies. Stallions, Colts, Mares, Fillies or Geldings.

1. Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh sections A and B. 1, 2 & 3 year olds.
- 1A. Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh sections A and B. 4 years old and over.
- 2 Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, Welsh sections C and D. 1, 2 & 3 year olds.
- 2A. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, Welsh sections C and D. 4 years old and over.

The 1st & 2nd placed ponies in classes 1 – 2A will qualify for the 2008 SWPA GOATLAKE FARM In-Hand M&M Championship.

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN

3. Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN

4. Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Mountain & Moorland First Ridden Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The 1st & 2nd placed exhibits in classes 3 – 4 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Mountain & Moorland Mini Ridden Championship.

First Place Exhibits in classes 3 – 4 will win a Julip Horse.

OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

5. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh sections A & B. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions)
6. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with the respective Pure Breed Societies of New Forest, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, Welsh C & D. Riders any age. (see rules for Ridden Stallions)

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Mountain & Moorland Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The 1st & 2nd placed exhibits in classes 5 – 6 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA GOATLAKE FARM Ridden M&M Championship.

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP:

1st & 2nd placed exhibits from classes 1 - 6 to compete. (Trophy to Champion)

SHOW PONY LEAD REIN

7. Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Show Pony Lead Rein Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

8. First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Show Pony First Ridden Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first & second placed exhibits in classes 7 – 8 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Open Mini Ridden Championship.

First Place Exhibits in classes 7 – 8 will win a Julip Horse.

RIDDEN SHOW PONIES

9. Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Show Pony Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first & second placed exhibits from class 9 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Ridden Riding Pony Championship.

RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

10. Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Show Hunter Pony Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The two highest placed ponies in class R10 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Ridden Show Hunter Championship.

OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP:

1st & 2nd placed exhibits from classes 7 – 10 to compete. (Trophy to Champion)

RIDING HORSES

11. Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Riding Horse Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first & second placed exhibits in classes 111 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Ridden Riding Horse Championship.

RIDDEN COBS

12. Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Cob Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first, second & third placed exhibits in class 12 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Ridden Cob Championship.

RIDDEN HUNTERS

13. Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Hunter Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first & second placed exhibits in class 13 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Ridden Hunter Championship.

RIDDEN PART BREDS

14. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses will not be ridden at the final.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Part Bred Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

15. Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Ridden Piebald / Skewbald Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008

OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP:

1st & 2nd placed exhibits from classes 11 – 15 to compete. (Trophy to Champion)

NOVICE RIDDEN

NOVICE RULES: NOT to have been placed first in ANY Ridden Class before the 1st January 2008.

SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY.

16. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, Any Height/Type. Riders Any Age (see rules for Ridden Stallions) (Class sponsored by Kalmara Native Ponies. www.kalmarastud.co.uk)

RING TWO.

Commencing 8.30am

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

Clear Round Jumping will take place from 8.30am – 10am & After the 3 WHP classes have finished.

£2 per round, payable on entry. - Rosettes to all Clear Rounds.

NOVICE RULES: NOT to have been placed first in ANY Working Hunter Class before the date of this show.

SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY.

NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

17. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, Any Height/Type. Riders Any Age (see rules for Ridden Stallions)

Will be jumped in height order:

- Not exceeding 122cms. Maximum height of fences 46cms.
- Exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 138cms. Maximum height of fences 61cms.
- Exceeding 138cms. Maximum height of fences 76cms.

WORKING HUNTER PONIES

18. Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride.

Will be jumped in height order:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 90cms.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 100cms.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 105cms.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Working Hunter Pony Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first, second & third placed exhibits from classes 18 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA Open Working Hunter Pony Championship.

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONIES

19. Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter pony, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Will be jumped in height order:

- Not exceeding 122cms. Maximum height of fences 64cms.
- Exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 138cms. Maximum height of fences 84cms.
- Exceeding 138cms. Maximum height of fences 99cms.

The three highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 15th – 17th August 2008.

The first, second & third placed exhibits in classes 19 will qualify for the 2008 SWPA M&M Working Hunter Pony Championship.

WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP:

1st & 2nd placed exhibits from classes 17 – 19 to compete. (Trophy to Champion)

SHOW RULES

The Show is run under the rules of the SWPA) constitution and general show rules.

All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed.

The organisers and owners of The Glebe, accept NO responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals or property. It shall be a condition of entry that competitors will hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings. We recommend that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance. All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the Secretary.

Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit any Pony/Horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

An exhibitor may not show an equine in a competition judged by any member of his/her immediate family.

An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced an equine since 1st October 2006.

A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition since the 1st October 2006.

The Judge's decision will be final.

All Ridden Equines MUST be 4 years old & over.

All Colts / Stallions two years old and over must be in possession of a current License. (unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society)

IN-HAND STALLIONS AND COLTS: *P(UK) RULES:* - Stallions / Colts may NOT be LED by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. RIDDEN STALLIONS: *RULES:* - Any Pony Stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors who have NOT attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

All Children MUST have attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year before competing in ANY ridden classes, and must comply with the upper limit of the class entered, and be prepared to supply a copy of their birth certificate if requested.

Correct British Standard Headgear conforming to PAS015 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163 or current standards to be worn at all times when mounted, with chinstraps from 3 points on the hat fastened.

Reins that restrict the natural movement of a pony/horse MUST not be used in the ring.

NO Spurs to worn in any ridden class and Showing Canes MUST not exceed 30". (unless deemed to part of the 'dress code' for the class entered).

NOVICE RIDDEN / NOVICE WHP CLASSES, SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY will be accepted.

Mountain & Moorland ponies MUST be shown in their natural state and trimming MUST comply with the respective Breed Society Stud Books. Mountain & Moorland ponies and Part Breds must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies and registration numbers to be stated on the entry forms and when entered on the day, (unless otherwise stated on the individual class). These conditions also apply to horses/ponies entered as Pure-bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs.

The organisers may divide/amalgamate/cancel classes as they see fit, without prior notice.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or ponies at the committee's / secretary's discretion and without assigning a reason.

ALL dogs MUST be kept on LEADS.

Objections must be in writing and given to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the relevant class and accompanied with a fee of £10.00 (refundable if the objection is upheld)

Entry fees are not refundable.

RIDER AGES FOR SHOW/RIDING & SHOW HUNTER TYPES

PLEASE NOTE: *Riders to be correct age for height of pony they ride.*

RIDER AGE RULES FOR SHOW/RIDING PONY NOVICE & OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES:

n/e 128cms, Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

exc 128cms - n/e 138cms, Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

exc 138cms - n/e 148cms, Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

RIDER AGE RULES FOR SHOW HUNTER NOVICE & OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES:

n/e 122cms, Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

exc 122cms - n/e 133cms, Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

exc 133cms - n/e 142cms, Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

exc 143cms - n/e 153cms, Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
